The mother work she undertook—navigating systems, building connections, and advocating for her son—served as a case study for this framework. Her practical knowledge and academic expertise have shown that a child's village—the people, systems, and relationships that surround them—has the power to transform lives. Her son's journey, from being nonverbal at nearly five years old to an incoming college freshman, is a testament to the power of intentional, collaborative ecosystems. This personal experience fuels her commitment to removing barriers and creating pathways to success for children and families.
